HIGH-VISIBILITY CLOTHING (HI VIS VEST OR SIMILAR) MUST BE WORN IN THE ENTIRE PORT AREA. WHEN WORKING IN QUAY AREAS SAFETY FOOTWEAR AND A SAFETY HELMET ARE ALSO REQUIRED.



FLYING A DRONE AND PHOTOGRAPHING WITHIN THE PORT AREA IS ONLY ALLOWED WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE PORT OF RAUMA.

Access permit

To access the port area, an access permit for the automatic access monitoring system is required.

The access permit can be issued by the company hosting the visit. People desiring to access the port area must be able to show their ID and provide a reason for their visit upon request. If the host of your visit has any problems with issuing an access permit, please contact the Main Gate Info where you might be provided a one-time access permit.

The holder of an access permit is personally responsible for the permit and can access the Port area at the responsibility of the host company. The access permit must not be handed over to anybody else. The holder of the permit is also responsible for any passengers riding in the same vehicle.

Visits to vessels may be authorized if the vessel has docked. Visitors have to be able to indicate the person they are going to visit. The vessel must provide the Main Gate Info a list of crew members and a guest list. The access permit may be denied or removed for a justified reason.

Gates

Access to the main gate is primarily through the main gate on Hakunintie road. Access to the port area requires that the vehicle/driver has a valid access permit.

At the main gate the vehicle is identified from the license plate, so before driving to the gate ensure the license plate is clean. Accessing the pedestrian gate at the main

gate requires a small, key ring size access permit tag for pedestrians and cyclists.

Access to the oil and chemical quays is through separate gates, Martinkari and Kallistuslaituri gates. Admission requires identification from the licence plate or a separate access permit tag. If necessary, contact the Main Gate Info by using the gate phones or by calling in +358 2 837 100.

Driving to the oil and chemical quays is forbidden when vessels are docked for loading or unloading.

Traffic in the harbour area

The speed limits in the port area:

- Hakunintie road 40 km/h
- container terminal 20 km/h
- other areas 30 km/h.



Parking is only permitted at the designated parking sites or parking spots.

Regular traffic rules and signs apply in the harbour area. Violation of the speed limits and other traffic regulations will result in a warning or a temporary cancellation of the access permit.

Beware of the railroad crossings and avoid walking at the port areas.

Use the traffic routes in the background areas (not quays) when moving from one harbour area to another. The work areas between unloading and loading vessels and the warehouses are exclusively reserved for stevedoring operations. All other traffic in

these areas is forbidden.

A recording camera surveillance system is in use in the harbour areas and the areas are also patrolled on a regular basis.



Minimize damage, use protective gear!

CE-marked high-visibility (EN ISO 20471) clothing (hi vis vest or similar) must be worn in the entire port area. In addition to the hi vis clothing, safety footwear and a safety helmet are also required when working in quay areas. Each terminal operator determines the protective and safety clothing required in their own terminal area. A helmet is not required inside machinery or vehicles.



The Rauma port area has a geographical restrictive UAS zone.

Go to www.elearning.fi/portofrauma and complete the safety orientation of the Port of Rauma. You may also use the computer at the Main Gate lobby.

AT THE MAIN GATE DETECTION POINT

- 1) Follow the traffic light and the instructions on the display panel.
- 2) If the gate doesn't open and the arrow guides you to the left, drive to the parking area. Don't reverse your vehicle!
- 3) Clean your license plate.
- 4) Drive to the detection point again.
- 5) If you still can't access the port area, drive to the parking area and contact the Main Gate Info.

IN EMERGENCY

3. Call the Main Gate Info +358 44 793 4700, which directs the rescue personnel to the accident scene.
4. Save.
5. Prevent other accidents.
6. Provide emergency first aid.
